- Stuart Langfield from the Motorcycle Advocacy Group has emailed and would like to attend a meeting to talk about noise issues. The meeting was unsure of the benefit in this.
- Shona & David explained the Ultra Trail Event being planned for July 2019 to reach out to show that they're available to answer and questions or concerns and to ensure that Mt Nebo received as much benefit as possible from this iconic event. There is a website with all the information which has had 17,000 views so far. The event is principally a 110k (100 mile) max 30 hour run with the Mt Nebo section going from The Gap SHS, along fire trails and bike paths, crossing the road at the Mt Nebo SS going to Miala. There will be a traffic management plan as runners will have support crews which will benefit local cafes and B'n'Bs. There are also shorter 30-60k runs similarly. The business model is to be 1. An epic race; 2. Environmentally responsible; 3. Have Community Involvement with fund raising opportunities.
- Rebecca and her sons attended the meeting to request support for a skate or BMX park on the mountain for local children. Angus pointed out that there was little for local children to do and that to use skateboards safely meant a long trip to other suburbs like Bracken Ridge, Paddington or Dorrington. The committee and meeting were very supportive of this suggestion although concerned that there may not be enough recreation reserves on the mountain.

Ross undertook to write to Cr Grimwade to find out the Council position.
